Devereaux Library serves the SDSM&T community. The four-story building, located on the north side of campus, provides a variety of resources and services to students, faculty, staff, area residents and visitors.

Library cards are needed to borrow materials from the library. SDSM&T campus ID cards serve as library cards. Students' cards are automatically activated after registration. Faculty and staff cards, however, must be manually entered into the library's system. It takes just a few minutes to have this process completed. Area residents may purchase a library card. Inquire at the Circulation Desk for more information.

Need Information?

The Devereaux Library offers a variety of resources, print, nonprint, and electronic.

- The book collection consists of thousands of printed works, fiction and non-fiction, on a multitude of topics. New books are added regularly. The library purchases a variety of books ranging from current best sellers to highly technical reference works
- As a federal depository library, Devereaux receives numerous Government Documents
- The library has more than 450 serial (magazines, journals, etc.) subscriptions and maintains an extensive backfile
- A federal Patent & Trademark Depository Library, Devereaux provides access to patent and trademark resources
- The map collection focuses primarily on the region, but does include maps covering the world and beyond.
- The library's video collection consists of VHS tapes and DVDs available for checkout. The collection includes hundreds of classic films and informational items. The Friends of the Devereaux Library provided significant funding to make these resources available
- Numerous audiobooks on compact disc and cassette tape are available
- The Library has a collection of recorded music on compact disc and vinyl
- Special collections include campus archives, the South Dakota Collection, and many individual collections focusing on the rich history of the region

The Devereaux Library provides access to a multitude of electronic resources. All electronic resources may be accessed via the library's website.

- South Dakota Library Network (SDLN) allows library users to search the holdings of Devereaux Library and dozens of other libraries throughout the state of South Dakota and beyond
- Full-text journal databases, EbscoHost, ProQuest and InfoTrac, are provided through SDLN
- Additional databases provided through SDLN include Contemporary Authors, SD Newspaper Association Indexes, NetLibrary, WorldCat
- The Devereaux Library provides access to Geobase, Environmental Sciences and Pollution Management, GeoRefS, SciFinder and Engineering Village's Compendex

Need a place to?

- Study tables and individual study carrels are available throughout the building
- Study rooms accommodate individuals or small groups for group or private study
- A television, VCR and DVD player are available for use in the building
- *downtime*, the popular reading area, houses current issues of popular magazines, newspapers, and best sellers; designed to be a place to relax and take a break, *downtime* is a gift from The Friends of the Devereaux Library
- Copy machines are located on the main floor and on the lower level
- A fax machine is available to send or receive campus related faxes for a nominal charge
